Our school board recently authorized me to have a census of pre-school children taken through schools of this county. I now have before me a report made by Mr. John L. Lancaster of the University of Virginia and I note that this report is made at your request. In looking through this report I do not feel assured that it has any reliability. In comparing the trends of school membership in the counties and the cities, I note that nearly every county drops in his projected membership to 1952 while the cities for the most part show very emphatical gains, in many instances more than doubling. Could it be possible that this report is based to a large extent on the statistics relating to births for the 6 years or for the period during the war and since and that Mr. Lancaster has failed to take into account the fact that births in hospitals outside of the county are reported through the registrar of the particular city or county where the hospital is located?
